JK Flooring UFH

To help us ensure that the underfloor heating installation proceeds as planned, please check the following measures are in place. Failure to do this could have serious implications on the ability to conduct our work and could result in an aborted installation and additional charges. All re-bookings are arranged subject to all other projects already scheduled, therefore your revised installation date could be several weeks hence.

There is not any one person either self-isolating or displaying symptoms of COVID-19 in the property where the installation is taking place

- All rooms requiring UFH are clear and free from obstruction. All furniture and old flooring have been removed
- There will be no other trades working in the areas of the UFH installation or using the electrical supply
- In order to operate our machinery during the installation we require TWO, separate, 32 Amp or minimum 20 Amp circuits from the consumer unit (fuse board). This can be a ground and first floor ring main or a ground floor and separate kitchen ring main etc. EACH of the above circuits must have at least one double socket available solely for JK operatives use whilst on site
- There must be access to an outside water tap/water supply
- A skip or designated place to dispose of the cutting waste is provided on site as it cannot be taken away. All waste will be bagged by the JK installers
- Areas where UFH is not required (eg. kitchen units, kitchen islands, fridges, etc) are marked out clearly on the floor
- >> UPDATED: From the removal of floor coverings prior to installation, should any black coatings be discovered on the floor surface these must be reported immediately and a procedure document can be shared. If not reported and discovered by the installation team on arrival this can and possibly will lead to an aborted installation. https://www.jk-qb.com/downloads/JK Floor Surface Procedure Illustrations.pdf

If any of the above measures cannot be met you should communicate this to your JK representative who will advise you further.

Please note - On the day of installation should the JK team discover that the floor is of a concrete nature, which had not been previously identified, then additional concrete cutting fees will be applied and added to your final invoice at the additional "per square metre" charge, as stated under Section 7. Quotation Information – Concrete in your quotation.
